Do not congregate outside the church doors.



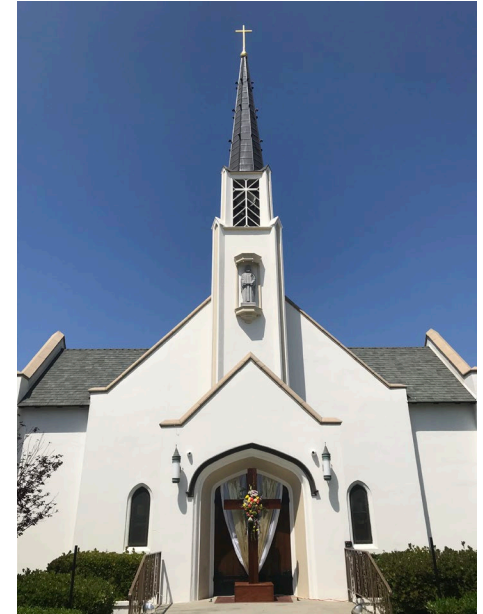

TIPS FOR ALL WORSHIPERS

What to expect when you go to Mass during COVID19

BEFORE YOU ARRIVE



Check your temperature: If you have 100.4 degree or higher, please do not come to church.



Stay home if you are ill, have a cough, chills, muscle pain, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell.



Make sure you have a face mask to bring and wear. Mask must be worn to be admitted.



You may bring a prayer book or worship aid such as The Word Among Us, Give Us This Day, or Magnificat. You may use any worship apps on your Smartphone. All copies of Breaking Bread have been removed from the pews.

Please make sure your ringer is turned off.

WHEN YOU ARRIVE



Keep face mask on at all times.



Enter & exit only through marked doorways



Wait patiently to be greeted.



Sanitize your hands as you enter.



Ushers will direct you to your seat.



Observe social distancing at all times. (Look for marks on the floor.)



There will be no passing of baskets for your Offertory Gifts, please leave your offering in the boxes provided at the entrance & exit areas.

DURING THE SERVICE



Do not roam or change seats at anytime once seated by Usher.



There will be no passing of offering baskets.



No physical Sign of Peace will be exchanged during Mass.



Instructions for receiving Holy Communion:

- Leave your seat only when directed by usher.
- Proceed to the altar, single-file
- Maintain 6 feet social distancing in the Communion line – look for marks on floor.
- When you approach the priest, do not remove your mask.
- Extend a single hand to receive the Holy Communion.
- Step to marked space, and consume Holy Communion. Replace your mask and exit the Church through the designated door.
